but we have not shone fully with your grace. Forgive our dullness,


cleanse all that obscures your light, and shine in us more perfectly, that we may be light for the world by the grace of Christ, with the radiance of your Holy Spirit. Amen.


\*HYMN Swiftly Pass the Clouds of Glory 1. Swiftly pass the clouds of glory, heaven's voice, the dazzling light; Moses and Elijah vanish; Christ alone commands the height! Peter, James, and John fall silent, turning from the summit's rise downward toward the shadowed valley where their Lord has fixed his eyes.
