


Love came down at Christmas, Love all lovely, love divine; Love was born at Christmas, Star and angels gave the sign.

I freely and heartily yield all things to thy pleasure and disposal.


And now, O glorious and blessed God,



Through the waters of the Red Sea, you brought your children to freedom.


By the baptism of water and the word, you created your church.

Blessed are all who come in your name, and blessed is Jesus, your Christ, baptized in the river Jordan, immersed in your grace, afloat on your love.


He washes our feet; he dries our tears; he gives us living water when we thirst for life.

we remember his death and resurrection, until he comes again.


