

SACRAMENT OF HOLY BAPTISM DECLAN ROLAND MEEHAN

INTRODUCTION

Pastor: The sacrament of baptism symbolizes the love by which God reaches out to us even when we are very young.We are here today to declare that God loves Declan and to offer ourselves as the instruments of that love in his life.

Parents: Because of God's love shown to us in Jesus Christ and the life of celebration this love brings, we want to have Declan baptized into the life and faith of this community.

We ask God's guidance in helping Declan to grow to respect himself and others.

We bring Declan here today with joy,

accepting the trust that has blessed us with his life.

Lay Leaders: On behalf of the congregation, we say to you, Patrick and Jordan, that Declan has with us here a community that is filled with love for him, our homes are his homes, and our resources are his resources.

Our faith will be taught to him.

We pray that we might fulfill our vows to you and to God.

<u>Children:</u> We are grateful for Declan's coming into our church family, and we want to share the love and faith with him.

Congregation: We, as a community, promise to care for Declan by our actions and style of life. We will teach him the joys of God's world. We will love him.

We are by this affirmation inseparably bound with him.

AFFIRMATION OF FAITH

Let us affirm our faith together.

Do you, as Christ's body, the church, reaffirm both your rejection of sin and your commitment to Christ?

We do.

Do you believe in God the Father?

I believe in God, the Father Almighty, creator of heaven and earth.

Do you believe in Jesus Christ?

I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried; he descended to the dead.

On the third day he rose again; he ascended into heaven, is seated at the right hand of the Father, and will come again to judge the living and the dead.

Do you believe in the Holy Spirit?

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting.

THANKSGIVING OVER WATER




